

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

Monitoring Requirements Not Met for AZ0402029

Our water system violated drinking water requirement over the past year. Even though these were not emergencies, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened and what we did to correct these situations.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for water quality parameters to determine if our system is properly controlling for lead and copper. During the required time frame, we did not complete all monitoring or testing for the water quality parameters listed below and therefore cannot be sure the quality of your drinking water during that time frame.

What should I do?

There is nothing you need to do at this time.

The table below lists the water quality parameters we did not properly test for, how often we are supposed to sample for these water quality parameters, how many samples we are supposed to take, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples will be taken.

Water Quality Parameters	Required Sampling Frequency	Number of Samples Taken	When samples should have been taken	When samples [were or will be] taken
pH	1 sample at each entry point to the distribution system every six months.	0	January – July 2022	January – June 2023
Temperature	1 sample at each entry point to the distribution system every six months.	0	January – July 2022	January – June 2023

What is being done?

The System will pull the corresponding samples in January – June 2023, going forward all samples will be pulled properly within the allowed timeframe of the sample schedule.
